

## NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

Notice is hereby given that on the 26th day of January 2026, the Upland City Council passed a resolution declaring unmaintained weeds, grasses, and vegetation, and dead or dying combustible debris a public nuisance and authorizing staff to initiate the annual weed abatement program. Public nuisance(s) will be abated by the city and the cost of removal assessed upon the land from or in front of which the weeds, rubbish, refuse, and dirt are removed and will constitute a lien upon such land until paid. Reference is hereby made to the resolution for further particulars. A copy of said resolution is on file in the office of the city clerk.

The City Council of the City of Upland will conduct a public hearing on Monday, July 27, 2026 at 6:00 p.m., or as soon thereafter as the case may be heard, in the City Council Chambers, 460 N Euclid Avenue, Upland, CA 91786, to consider declaring certain weeds, rubbish, refuse, and dirt in the public right-of-way and private property within the City of Upland, in the State of California, to be public nuisances and providing for the abatement thereof. Pursuant to Upland Municipal Code Section 8.12.080 notices will be mailed to affected property owners.

All interested parties having any objections to the proposed removal of the weeds, rubbish, refuse, and dirt are hereby notified to attend the hearing and will be afforded the opportunity to present oral and written statements, arguments, or beliefs relevant to the nuisance(s). All pertinent data may be inspected at the Upland City Hall, 460 N. Euclid Avenue, 909-931-4134, prior to the public hearing.

If you challenge the weed abatement procedures or the related environmental determination in court, you may be limited to raising only those issues you or someone else raised at the public hearing described in this notice, or in written correspondence delivered to the City of Upland, at or prior to, the public hearing.

It is the intention of the City of Upland to comply with the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA). If you require special assistance beyond what is normally provided, the City will attempt to accommodate you in every reasonable manner.
