Dear Senator Archuleta,

On behalf of the City of Upland, I am writing to express the City's support for Senate Bill 907, which strengthens penalties and accountability for serious driving-related offenses, particularly those involving impaired driving and repeat violations.

SB 907 takes a comprehensive approach to addressing dangerous driving behavior by enhancing penalties for repeat DUI offenders, increasing consequences for hit-and-run violations tied to prior offenses, and allowing for stronger sentencing in cases of vehicular manslaughter. These updates appropriately reflect the serious risks posed by impaired and reckless drivers, particularly in communities like ours where traffic safety remains a top public safety priority.

Importantly, the bill ensures that individuals with prior DUI-related convictions face escalating consequences, reinforcing deterrence and accountability. By also expanding judicial authority to impose consecutive sentencing in severe cases, SB 907 provides courts with the tools necessary to address repeat and high-risk offenders who pose a continued threat to the public.

Local governments bear the direct impacts of traffic collisions, emergency response, and roadway safety challenges. Strengthening state law in this area supports ongoing local efforts to reduce injuries and fatalities on roadways in Upland and throughout California.

For these reasons, the City of Upland respectfully supports SB 907.
